\$10,000 SAFE COP REWARD MORGANVILLE, NJ, AUGUST 26, 2008:

Executive Director Joseph Occhipinti announced the posting of the \$10,000 Safe Cop Reward in connection with the Shooting of Philadelphia Police Officer Martin P. Campbell who was accompanied by his longtime friend Rasheen Allen who was also shot by a mortal gunshot wound to the head and died on the scene by the same unknown assailants in Philadelphia, Pennsylvania.

The Safe Cop program is a congressionally recognized law enforcement initiative of the National Police Defense Foundation that posts up to a \$10,000 reward for public information leading to the arrest and conviction of any person who shoots at a law enforcement officer, anywhere in the United States.

The Safe Cop program was established in 1995 and has been instrumental in the arrest and conviction of several suspects involved in police related shootings.
