SUBJECT: Terminated NPDF Photo-ID Credentials &
Badge Program

A review of our membership records disclosed that you are an active or past member in possession of expired NPDF Photo-ID badge credentials.

In June 2006, the National Police Defense Foundation suspended the photo-ID badge credential program for homeland security concerns and switched to a non-photo ID credential with a smaller 2" NPDF sized badge.

Those members were directed to surrender the larger sized NPDF Photo-ID badge credentials and were cautioned that their continued use of those documents is prohibited.

All NPDF Members were advised that if they surrendered those expired Photo-ID badge credentials, the NPDF would replace them at no extra charge for the newer version of the smaller sized, non-photo, MEMBER ID badge credential.

Several members opted to keep those credentials as a souvenir to be stored in their home or office. There were reports from certain members that those expired credentials were either lost or stolen wherein they were directed to file an appropriate police report.

On April 15, 2008, Deborah L. Zoland, the New York City Police Department Assistant Deputy Commissioner for Legal Matters mandated that the NPDF instruct all members (past or active) in possession of the larger sized NPDF Photo-ID badge credentials to immediately surrender them or risk in the State of New York and five boroughs of the City of New York being charged with criminal impersonation and other related charges.

Please return the expired NPDF photo-ID credentials and larger sized badge in your possession in the self addressed enclosed envelope. In the event they were lost or stolen, please promptly advise the NPDF so appropriate notification can be made to the New York City Police Internal Affairs Bureau.

I would again reiterate that any use by you of the expired NPDF photo-ID badge credentials and larger sized badge could lead to criminal prosecution against you. Therefore, do not use this expired identification for any purposes whatsoever.
